The stirring sound of the *shofar* proclaimed the covenant at Mount Sinai which bound Israel to Elohim as a kingdom of priests and a holy people. Ever since that distant day, the voice of the *shofar* has resounded through the habitations of Israel awakening high allegiance to Elohim and His commandments. Adonai, sustain us with hope that we may confidently await the day when knowledge of You shall reach the uttermost parts of the world. Hasten the blessed time when all dwellers on the earth shall hearken unto the sound of the *shofar* and shall worship together at Your holy mountain. Just as lightening comes from the east and flashes to the west, so shall the coming of the Son of Man be. Adonai Himself will descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the *shofar* of Elohim; and the dead in Messiah shall rise first. Then we who remain

alive shall be caught up together with them in the clouds to meet Adonai in the air, and so we shall always be with Adonai. You will judge the nations and set up Your Messianic kingdom.
