Indeed, we allowed the subtle idols of materialism, lust, greed, pride, and tradition without faith and power to be as idols in our hearts.

We do now repent for our people and ask forgiveness. For we are not without hope.

For You have promised that "All Israel shall be saved." We shall yet say as a people, "Baruch haba baShem Adonai."

We will look upon Him whom we have pierced and mourn for Him.

Then shall the great promise be fulfilled, a fountain shall be open for cleansing in that future great Yom Kippur. Then shall we be re-gathered to our land in a greater Exodus, and the nations will come to Your light. There will be peace and deliverance from all our enemies.

Then ten men from the nations will take hold of the tzitzit of a Jew and say, "Let us go with you, for we have heard that Elohim is with you."

In that day all nations shall celebrate the feast of Sukkot in Jerusalem. Adonai shall be King over all the earth and His Name shall be one.


